

# Mayflower Heritage Christian School

## Admissions Policy

Admission to Mayflower Heritage Christian School is obtained by completing the written application, signing the Vision, Mission, and Faith Statement, your minister's signature on the church affiliation page, a personal meeting with an administrator, & receiving previous school records. Entrance tests or assessments will be conducted by the teacher with the prospective student.

A student must be 5 years old on or before September 15th of a given school year in order to be admitted into kindergarten. A student must be 6 years old on or before September 15th of a given school year to be admitted into first grade. Any exceptions to this must be approved by the Board.

Previous disciplinary or education problems need to be discussed with school representatives before registration. Falsification of information or withholding pertinent information in these areas may lead to a request to withdraw from the school. We are a school that is here for the benefit of Christian families, but cannot meet the needs of all students. We want each student's experience here to be beneficial to their relationship with God and advancing their academic progress. Mayflower Heritage Christian School may, at any time, request the withdrawal of any student who is not in harmony with the spirit of the school, regardless of whether or not he conforms to specific rules.

Parents are asked to agree to a parent-student handbook and sign the vision, mission, and faith statements as a requirement for admission. This is done for all students on an annual basis. A tuition/fee schedule is published yearly. The Board reserves the right to require a specific payment schedule from a family, if circumstance warrant.

Mayflower Heritage Christian School admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race color, national or ethnic origin in administrations of its educational policies, scholarship and loan programs and athletic or other school administered programs. The school will not discriminate on the basis of race, color or ethnic origin in the hiring of its certified teachers or non-certified personnel.
