Basic Bible Truth/Doctrine: REDEMPTION

Redemption is a word borrowed from the commercial world of the ancient near east (where slaves were bought and sold). This word in the Bible describes how Jesus has “ *purchased*” us in the marketplace of sin in order to set us free from sin’s bondage. The story of Hosea’s purchase of Gomer in the Old Testament book by his name is a perfect example of this transaction (Hosea 3:1-2) Peter has the same concept in mind when he writes, “ *it was not with perishable things such as silver and gold that you were redeemed, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.*” 1 Peter 1:18,19

PRINCIPLE:

- GOD HAS ULTIMATE SOVEREIGNTY OVER ALL HISTORY.
- JESUS BLOOD PURCHASED BELIEVERS FOR GOD
- WE ARE TO PRAISE AND HONOR GOD THE FATHER, GOD THE SON, AND GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT FOREVER AND EVER
