7. In Genesis chapter 49 Jacob blesses his 12 sons and in verse 9 calls his son Judah “*a lions cub*”. What does Genesis 49:10 say about the tribe of Judah?

8. As we remember the advent of the first coming of Jesus as a baby at Christmas what does Luke 2:4 say about Joseph and Mary?
