

REVIEW:

1. What did you learn last week from the background of the book of Revelation?

READ Revelation 1:1-3

2. From Rev. 1:1 what is the book about?

3. The word revelation means “ *an unveiling or a disclosure of that which is previously hidden or unknown*. In Revelation we will see Jesus Christ revealed in His glory. From Daniel 2:28 who reveals mysteries?

4. From Rev. 1:1 who gave this revelation to Jesus Christ? To whom was Jesus Christ to show this revelation?

5. What was He to show His servants?

6. How did Jesus Christ make the Revelation known? What does John then do? vs 1:1b-2

7. Who does God say is blessed in Rev. 1:3?

What does the following verse say: James 1:22?

8. Who was John writing to and what does he desire for them? Who does he say this blessing is from? 1:4-5a

9. Compare the description of THE LORD in Rev. 1:4 to who He says He is in Exodus 3:14 and John 8:58.

10. Rev. 1:4 speaks of the “seven spirits before his throne”. Seven is a symbol of completeness and perfection in the Bible. From Isaiah 11:2 describe the Holy Spirit in all His fullness.

11. Describe Jesus Christ from 1:5

12. To be a “*faithful witness*” you must tell the truth about what you have personally seen. In John 3:11 Jesus is speaking. What does He witness and testify to?

13. Jesus Christ is “*the first born from the dead*” . What does Colossians 1:18 say about Him being firstborn from the dead?

14. What titles are given to Jesus in Rev. 17:14 and 19:16 that compare to the third thing that is said of Him in Rev. 1:5?

15. From Rev. 1:5, what is Jesus Christ present feeling toward us?

Read Hebrews 13:8. Will His love for you ever change?

16. What has Jesus Christ done for us? 1:5-6

17. Describe THE LORD’S return from 1:7

Compare the description of The Lord’s return in 1:7 with Acts 1:10-11

18. Revelation 1:8 restates who the Author of the Book of Revelation is- How is he described in vs 8?

19. *Alpha and Omega* are the first and the last letters of the Greek alphabet. How do Isaiah 43:10 and 44:6 help us understand what John is saying in 1:8?

20. What do you most want to remember or what meant the most to you from these first 8 verses in the Revelation of Jesus Christ?
