5. From the following verses, name some others who have seen into heaven. And what did they see?

10. Describe what Jesus saw in 4:2-3.

11. From 4:10-11 who is seated on “The *throne*”?

12. From Ezekiel 1:26-28 how does the prophet describe his vision of God?

13. In Psalm 103:19 we read “*The Lord establishes His throne in heaven, and His Kingdom rules over all.*” In Rev.4:3b what encircled the throne?

What is the rainbow and why was it given? Look to Genesis 9:13-17

14. What surrounded the throne and who sat there? 4:4- How were they described?

What came from the throne?

15. From 4:5b and 6a what else was before the throne?

16. From Revelation 4:6b – 7 what was “*in the center around the throne*” and what were they “*like*” ?

17. What else does 4:8a tell us about these “creatures”? And what do they never stop saying?

18. How did the prophet Isaiah see The Lord on His throne in Isaiah 6:1-3 and what were the “seraphs” calling to one another?

19. “*The Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come.*” How do the following verses confirm this truth?
